## Uniform Reminder

As we enter the summer, I want to remind you of the district uniform policy. I know many of you will purchase clothes during the summer to prepare for next year.

Students are required to be in uniform each school day. Students need to be in collared shirts. Shirt colors for KES are: white, navy, and forest green. **Collared shirts should be solid, one color.** The shirts cannot have designs on them or stripes.

**Uniform shorts should be one solid color** of the following: khaki, navy, or dark denim (jean shorts). Shorts should not have designs on them or plaid stripes.

**The district uniform policy also states hairstyles cannot be so distracting or disruptive that it interferes with the orderly educational process. These include hairstyles such as:**

**Mohawk style, extreme spiked hair and similarly unusual and distracting hairstyles.**

If your child wishes to have a Mohawk, please do it during the summer but cut hair before returning to school to be in line with the district policy on hair and dress.
